Dear Lisbon Families,


In an effort to provide you with the most updated information related to the impact of COVID-19 on our schools, I am writing to inform you that **the Lisbon School Department will remain closed until, at least, Friday, May 1, 2020**, with decisions on re-opening or potentially extending the closure being made at that time.

As you know, on Tuesday, March 31, 2020, Governor Mills issued a “Stay Healthy at Home” mandate which extended the timeline for Maine schools to cease classroom-based instruction until Friday, May 1, 2020, or until further order. As a result, we will continue to implement our “Distance Learning Plan” with the primary focus, over the next few weeks, being on review and reflection. I wanted to also notify you that there will not be any online instruction or support available during our Spring Break from April 20th-24th. We will however still be providing meals at each of our “Mobile Food Sites” during that week so please contact our office at 353-6711 X1014 if you have any questions.

As I have mentioned before, this notification is an effort to communicate this news to you as soon as possible so that you may continue planning for child care and other concerns that have occurred as a result of this extended closure.
